And, as with auctions, entitlements in option-based law naturally flow to those who value them the most. Seeing legal entitlements through this lens suggests a variety of new entitlement structures from which lawmakers might choose. *Optional Law* provides a theory for determining which structure is likely to be most effective in harnessing parties' private information.
