Anne was only a child while she lived freely at Merwedeplein 37 in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, and barely a teenager when she died in a Nazi concentration camp for the simple "crime" of being Jewish. Anne wanted to "go on living after [her] death" in February or March 1945, and I hope we have honored her lasting wish in this work.
